




International Airport Munich



Munich International Airport is only two hours away and may serve as an additional international hub for your delegates.

Distance to Alpbach: 160 km | 1 h 45 by car

Distance to Innsbruck: 197 km | 2 h by car

Distance to Seefeld: 161 km | 2 h by car

Distance to Gurgl: 300 km | 3 h 28 by car

Distance to Kals/Osttirol: 250 km | 3 h 20 by car

Innsbruck

Innsbruck's main station is one of the busiest in Austria. Inter-City and Euro-City **trains from all major European cities** call at the centrally located main station in Innsbruck.

There are **high speed and convenient connections** to the capital city of Vienna (only 4 h 15), via Salzburg (1 h 45), or to Munich (2 h) and also Zurich/Switzerland (3 h 40).

Tirol is the region of short distances. Usually delegates can easily cover all routes by foot. Still Tirol's public transport systems provide excellent mobility for their guests, thanks to fully developed city bus and tram lines, taking care of your travel needs around the clock. Optionally we can provide you with either beneficial day passes for each and every delegate or organize congress tickets for the whole stay at very reasonable rates.

Other congress regions

Express trains (ICE, IC, EC, RJ) stop at the express train stations of Kufstein, Jenbach, Wörgl, Ötztal Bahnhof, Landeck. St. Anton. That way all our congress centers are well and sustainably connected.

Some regions offer free bus services on-site for public transportation buses or special congress guest cards for additional benefits of several kinds.

VAT situation in Austria

20% VAT - all other taxable goods and services

13% VAT - Domestic flights; entrance to sporting events; admissions to cultural events and amusement parks; hotel accommodation; firewood; some agricultural supplies; wine production; cut flowers and plants for decorative use

10% VAT foodstuffs; water supplies; pharmaceutical products; domestic transport (excluding flights); international and intra-community road and rail transport; newspapers and books; restaurants (ex all beverages);

o%VAT - Intra-community and international transport (excluding road and rail)

As a general rule, the company which provides the goods or services must invoice VAT. This does not apply to cross-border supplies of goods and services if the recipient is a company abroad. This is where the so-called "general clause" comes into force, according to which a service provided to a business based abroad (B2B) is considered to have been performed at the place from which the beneficiary operates (place-of-supply principle).

In this case, Austrian VAT law is not applicable, therefore Austrian VAT is not charged. Reverse charging (transfer of tax liability) then applies according to which the obligation to pay VAT is passed on to the foreign business. The supplying business will simply issue an invoice for the net amount to the customer (no VAT being invoiced). The invoice must state the VAT numbers of the supplier and the recipient (if EU) as well as a note that the amount is not taxable in Austria owing to the system of reverse charging being applied.

Visa information

Nationals of EU member states, the European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland do not require a visa for entering the Republic of Austria. All other nationals require a visa in order to enter the Schengen Area or the Austrian territory.

For stays of up to 90 days per 180 days these individuals require a Schengen visa, given that they do not take up employment. Both information regarding special rules applicable for Family members of EU/EEA nationals and the Visainformation (VIS) can be found on the homepage of the European Commission.

Nationals of countries which signed bilateral or multilateral agreements on the abolition of visa requirement are visa-free if they stay in Austria for a maximum period of 90 days and do not take up employment. © 2018 Federal Ministry for Europe, Integration and Foreign Affairs


